Camille is well-known to the Foundation through her efforts as the Global Head of Product Security Strategy at Google, in helping the Foundation secure approximately Ja\$27,000,000, which was used to purchase Chromebooks for the Mathematics Honours College, an initiative designed to improve the passes in the Caribbean Secondary Examination Certificate (CSEC) mathematics examination,



across the six high schools in St. Thomas, and Happy Grove High School in Portland.
